Fare Refund Procedure (Instructions)

Fare Refund:

- 1. Refunds of post-payment money for travel already made along the BAKAD are not provided.
- 2. The advance payment is subject to refund, provided that the User has not yet traveled along the BAKAD.

The period during which the User can contact the Operator for a refund advance payment (prepayment): - 3 (three) years.

The period for consideration of the User's application by the Operator: 15 (fifteen) business days.

The conditions for the return of the prepayment (advance) payment to the User may be carried out in the following cases:

- 1) Incorrectly (erroneously) specified by the User the State Registration Number in the Operator's ITPS system.
- 2) Incorrectly indicated payment amount, exceeding the desired amount.
- 3) Deregistration of a vehicle.

User actions to return the prepayment (advance payment):

- 1. Consideration of the issue of refund of the advance payment
 The Operator is only able to do this upon a written application from the User (in a form approved by the Operator).
- 2. In the application, the User must indicate:
 - Full name:
 - IIN:
 - mobile phone number;
 - make and model of vehicle;
 - GRNZ;
 - bank details;
 - reasons and grounds for return.
- 3. The following must be attached to the application:
 - a check or receipt for the payment made;
 - a copy of the identity card;
 - a copy of the vehicle registration certificate;
 - a copy of the insurance policy if the application is not submitted by the owner of the vehicle.

Actions of the Operator to return the prepayment (advance payment):

- 1. The operator in the ITPS system checks the presence or absence of completed trips of the User's vehicle along the BAKAD.
- 2. In the event of no vehicle travel, the Operator will return the money to the User's bank account from which the payment was made.
- 3. The operator transfers money from the erroneously specified GRNZ account to the correct GRNZ account.
- 4. In the event of deregistration of a vehicle, the Operator transfers money to the State Registration Number account of another User vehicle.
